Event Idea: Grand Reopening Event

Whether you've held a Grand Opening Event in the past, or you've just opened your doors for the first time in a while due to COVID-19 restrictions, a Grand Reopening event is a great way to reengage with your customers and referral sources.



The goal of this event is to provide your current and prospective students something of value at little to no cost that can help them in their education journey. Reengage with referral sources in your community and get students registering for tutoring. Encourage current and past students to attend and bring a friend!

Event Idea: Holiday Dress-Up

If you're looking to get your foot into the door at daycares, schools, or community centers, dressing up like Mr. and Mrs. Claus and handing out candy could be a great way to provide something back to your community and getting out and about meeting people. You may choose to go door-to-door in an apartment complex, or if you're trying to get on the good side of the principal down the street, offering this free to their students, if allowed, might be a foot in the door!

You don't want to turn this into you just simply marketing your business, but don't forget to have School is Easy marketing collateral on hand, just in case anyone asks!

The goal of this event is to give back to the community representing your School is Easy business and get out and talking to parents, teachers and students.

Whenever you invite people to an event, remember that simply visiting isn't enough of an incentive. Events need to be ATTRACTIVE in order to receive attendance – you must position a HOOK in your invitations, by offering something for free (or at a fee, depending on what's on offer). A free seminar, introductory lesson, or workshop is commonly used. You could also consider these other suggestions:

- Host a free test preparation session
- Reach out to local schools, centers, and groups do they have an upcoming event you can attend and set up a booth at?
- When hosting an event, provide light refreshments, or better yet, partner with a local business to provide this.
- Establish your own networking group "Sponsored by School is Easy"
- Provide a free information session on funding and getting tutoring paid for.
- Offer giveaways.
- Get a local radio station to participate, broadcast your event live, and provide music.
- Advertise your event on social media, run ads, create an Eventbrite listing.
- Offer a referral incentive to anyone who refers a student to School is Easy and they sign up for tutoring during the event or before a certain date.
- Provide free testing advice during your event.
- Offer free branded School is Easy gear to the first 25 attendees.
- Create and run a press release about your event.

Event Idea: SAT/ACT Prep Seminar or Webinar

Getting students or prospects to actually attend your event can be the most difficult part. It's important to not only allow enough time for you to market your event, but also provide value to your attendees. Parents who are preparing their child for college may not know where to start when it comes to the SAT or ACT tests. You can contact local schools and offer to give a free information seminar to parents regarding these tests and how they can prepare their students. Similar to other events, use this as an opportunity to collect parents email addresses or contact information and add them to your marketing list. You don't want to turn the talk into a "hard sell," but rather an opportunity for parents to ask questions and for you to follow up later.
